Course description:

The course begins and ends at the intersection of West Liberty and Main Street. It starts by heading north on Main Street and then west on Washington Ave to 1st Street. From there it heads south to Liberty Street, where it heads east to Ashley Street. This is where it heads south again until hitting Jefferson Street going east to Main Street. Cyclists will then speed north on Main Street to cross the finish line.
